



## UNDERGRADUATE CURATORIAL INTERNSHIPS

Academic Year 2023–24

The Block Museum of Art internships are available to Northwestern University undergraduate students from various academic programs and disciplines. Block internships provide hands-on experience in the context of an academic art museum and offer opportunities to learn about curatorial museum work; projects may include work on collections, exhibitions, community relations, publications, and/or programs with an emphasis on writing and research. Interns will meet with staff members throughout the year to learn about different museum careers. The Block encourages applications from BIPOC students and members of groups underrepresented in careers related to museums and the visual arts.

The interns will be paid \$15 per hour and can work up to 10 hours per week during the fall, winter, and spring quarters. Work may be scheduled throughout the academic year, between September 19, 2023 and June 7, 2024. (Interns may vary the number of hours they work per quarter, depending on course load.)

### APPLICATION

#### 1) Cover Letter

Please include a statement about your interest in the internship and your professional and academic goals. Include information on your coursework, prior experience, and qualifications for the position.

The Block Museum recognizes that museum internships can be an important part of the path that leads to increased BIPOC (Black, Indigenous and People of Color) representation in the museum and cultural sector. If you identify as BIPOC and would like to share this information, please do so in your cover letter.

#### 2) Resume

Please include your major, if declared, your anticipated graduation date, your employment history, and a list of relevant courses completed.
